TWO YEAR OLDS (David)

1. Who did God send to find a king? God sent Samuel
2. Who did God tell Samuel to choose? God told Samuel to choose David.

Memory Verse: For God so loved the world that He gave His only son, that whoever believes in Him will not perish but have everlasting life. **John 3:16**

THREE YEAR OLDS (Zacchaeus/Jesus Loves Everyone)

1. Who did ask for a drink of water from at the well? Jesus asked a woman from Samaria for a drink.
2. After she gave him a drink, what happened? She believed in Jesus and told everyone about Him.

Memory Verse: Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him and He will make your paths straight.

Proverbs 3:5-6

4/5 YEAR OLDS (I will give)

1. While Jesus was Lazarus' house, what did Mary do? She washed Jesus' feet with very expensive perfume.
2. How should we be like Mary? Jesus wants us to give with a loving heart.

Memory Verse: Put on the full armor of God. Stand firm then with the belt of truth, the breastplate of righteousness, and our feet fitted for the Gospel of Peace. Take up the shield of faith, the helmet of salvation, the sword of the spirit, which is the word of God. **Ephesians 6:13-17**

KINDERGARTEN (God is more powerful than anything)

1. Who was Joshua and the Israelites fighting in the Promised Land? They were fighting 5 kings and their armies.
2. Who won and how did they win? Joshua did because God answered his prayers through his awesome power.

Memory Verse: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. Amen

1st – 3rd GRADERS (Who Am I?)

1. When I choose to follow Jesus, God forgives all of our sins, faults, and mistakes. When did God choose to accept us this way? Even before He made the world.
2. What does accepted mean? I am liked. I am apart of the group.
3. Does knowing that God accepts you make you want to sin more, or does it make you want to live like Jesus more? Why? Answers will vary

Memory Verse: Even before He made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in His eyes.

Ephesians 1:4(NLT)

FUEL45 4th/5th GRADERS (You Want)

1. If you could have ANYTHING you want what would it be and why?
2. What is a selfish want VS an unselfish want?
3. Do you think God will give us whatever we ask Him for?
4. Discuss things that God wants us to want! (Salvation for everyone, love, treating others with kindness, etc.)

TEXT: Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart.

CHARACTER OF THE MONTH: Honesty

Honesty is defined as being truthful in what I say and do. Honesty with ourselves is the first step to living truthfully. Lying to oneself skews the way one views the world and can leave one unprepared to handle reality. Honesty prepares us to face reality and accept it. It prepares us to speak the truth, whether or not it is commonly accepted, whether it brings pleasure or pain, or whether it serves immediate interests or not. If we are to be truthful, we must diligently search for truth and take personal responsibility to adjust our views according.
